ARTICLE 1: ORGANISATION The Western Cape Road & Individual Time Trial Championships will take place in accordance with the Rules and Regulations of the UCI (International Cycling Union) and Cycling South Africa. Any infringements will be disposed of in terms of Chapter 12 of the UCI Rules and Regulations and by participating in the event, riders and managers acknowledge and subject themselves to all relevant UCI and Event Special Rules and Regulations.

Distances: as per the Start list: The final start list will be posted on the Jakhals Events website.

Article 2: Participation

All riders participating in the Western Cape Championship must be in possession of a 2021 valid membership issued by Cycling SA.

Article 3: Type of Races & Points Awarded

- a) All races conducted will be Western Cape Championships;
- b) Each cyclist must ensure they understand the layout for the particular route of his/her age group inclusive of the in/out routing scheduled and the circuit;
- c) All races will be Closed Championships.

Article 4: Permanence (Race Meeting office and Head Quarters)

Race permanence is at Grand Hotel, Laingsburg

Race Registration / Number Collection: The number collection is as follows:

- Friday 23 April 2021: 13 h00 18h00: Grand Hotel, Laingsburg
- Saturday 24 April 2021: 11h00 15h00: Grand Hotel, Laingsburg
 17h00 19h00: Grand Hotel, Laingsburg

A Managers meeting will take place on Friday 23 April 2021 – 18h00, Saturday 24 April 2021

11h00, to be held at the Race Permanence
 Grand Hotel, Laingsburg

Article 5: Radio-Tour

- a) No radios are permitted for riders in the road race;
- b) Commissaires & Neutral Vehicles will have a radio;
- c) The Organisation / Teams / Commissaires will also make use of Cellular phones communication (Whattsapp Communication). This is because of some signal challenges.











Article 6: Neutral Service

- a) A neutral service vehicle shall be arranged for each distance;
- b) Team Vehicles are also encouraged to assist where possible, even if riders are not of their team. SAFETY is a very important aspect.
- c) Riders withdrawing from the race must report their withdrawals to the President Commissaire or Chief Judge at the Finish Line.

Article 7: Following vehicles

Article 8: Prize Giving & Protocol

- a) Medal winners must be on time for Prize Giving and need to adhere to the Covid 19 regulations. Time slots for the prize giving will be published on social media & the Jakhals Events website.
- b) Riders must adhere to the UCI rules with regards to the PODIUM PROTOCOL

Article 9: Anti-Doping / Medical Control

- a) The Anti-Doping Protocol and Rules of the UCI, SAIDS and Cycling SA will apply.
- b) Riders in the U19 (Junior) category must be accompanied by an adult (team manager or parent) with the necessary identifications.
- c) The Anti-Doping premises will be clearly marked and will be at the START / FINISH area.

Article 10: Bicycles & Equipment

a) Road Races

- i. No bicycles should be left unattended.
- ii. It will be each rider's individual responsibility to ensure that all wheels and equipment given to Neutral service vehicles will be marked and collected after each event.
- iii. The first five riders from the U19 (Junior) Category must do a gear check immediately after the race has been completed.
- iv. All riders must sign on after successful bicycle inspection and not leave the waiting area.

b) Time Trial

- i. Each rider has to have his/her bicycle inspected and weighed in before the start of the TT and cannot leave the starting area again.
- ii. Each rider has to have the bicycle inspected and rolled-in at least 30 minutes prior to his/her starting time.
- iii. Strict Rules will apply as per the new regulations of the UCI.
- iv. Riders must know and adhere to the UCI rules pertaining to catching another rider.
- v. Elites, U23, U19 (Junior), Vets/Masters, please check the Cycling SA or UCI website for the Time Trial Bike Specifications.

c) Race Numbers

You will receive 2 x back numbers and a frame number in your race pack.

One back number to be used for the Time Trial.

Two back numbers will be used for the Road Race. Please make sure that your number(s) is clearly visible at all times for the officials.











A deposit of R200.00 will be required for the numbers. When numbers are returned undamaged, deposits will be refunded

NB: District Team Manager of youth riders will have to pay R 500 as a number deposit per district

IMPORTANT: AT REGISTRATION ALL COVID 19 PROTOCOLS WILL BE FOLLOWED. NO MASK – NO ENTRY

Article 11: STARTS OF TIME TRIAL & ROAD RACES:

• Individual Time Trials: Riders must adhere to the Covid 19 protocols. All riders must keep social distancing and riders must wear their masks until just before their starts.

NO CROWDING WILL BE ALLOWED.

• **Road Races:** The various bunches / groups will line up as indicated by the Commissaires / Organisers in charge.

At all times riders will wear a mask, until just before the start of their race.

NO SPECTATORS WILL BE ALLOWED AT THE START / FINISH VENUES

SCREENING:

- Screening will be done before the Individual Time Trial and the Road Races.
- Temperature check / Q & A for symptoms
- If you were in contact with any persons tested positive for Covid 19, please DO NOT attend the event.
- The wear of masks at all times at the START / FINISH venues are compulsory.
- We are responsible to keep ourselves and others safe!
